Enjoy Rohnert Park's Halloween Festivities

Rohnert Park, CA (Oct. 6, 2023) – Rohnert Park is the place to be this fall. From sweet treats to haunted houses, these upcoming Halloween events have frights and fun in store for everyone this month!

The City is hosting The Haunt – Brew and Scare Fest on October 27 from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. This outdoor event will be at the Rohnert Park Community Center and will feature free games and a live performance by local favorite, Aqua Nett. Sol Azteca Taqueria and Chava's Pizza food trucks will be available for purchase, and Rohnert Park's Old Caz Brewing Company will also be pouring their finest brews and wines for purchase. Tickets are \$35 per person and grant access to all activities, including a terrifying 5,000 square foot haunted maze. The first 50 ticket buyers will snag an exclusive Haunt Fest Graphic Tee. The fun continues on Saturday, October 28 at noon at the Halloween Carnival and Dia de Los Muertos Celebration at the Rohnert Park Community Center. This event is hosted by the City of Rohnert Park in partnership with the Cotati Rohnert Park Unified School District and the Latino Alliance. Paid activities include carnival games, food, drinks and face painting. The carnival game funds contribute to the outdoor educational camp at Nature Bridge Golden Gate Campus for all Rohnert Park fifth-graders. Admission and all other attractions are free.
