Rohnert Park Capital Improvements Program Continues Public Works Projects

Rohnert Park, CA (Nov. 3, 2023) – Rohnert Park is pleased to announce new public works projects. Roadway and water and sewer utility improvements are set to take place in the A & B section neighborhoods this year.

Rohnert Park's **Capital Improvement Program (CIP)** guides improvement plans each year. This year, the city is investing over 10 million dollars into infrastructure improvement projects. These include ongoing pothole repairs and sidewalk replacements.

“We are committed to providing excellent infrastructure and facilities for our community,” said Mayor Samantha Rodriguez. “We understand the importance of reliable roads and utilities, so it is exciting to see these projects making progress.”

This year, Rohnert Park will be improving water and sewer utilities in the A & B section neighborhoods. Starting this winter, the city will be replacing a part of the deteriorating main water pipe. These upgrades will repair the aging sanitary sewer system, which helps protect public health and water quality.

Once the utility updates are complete, the city plans to do major road maintenance for those neighborhoods. This will fix and renovate any damage done to streets during utility maintenance. This will improve road quality and increase the service life of those streets. Well-maintained streets and pavements make road transportation safer and more pleasant. They also require less frequent updates.
