Traffic Collision Leads to DUI Arrest

ROHNERT PARK – On Sept 6th at approximately 0227 AM, Rohnert Park Officers were called to the area of 7701 Beverly Dr. for a report of a vehicle accident. As officers arrived, they located one male standing outside of a green Mazda Pickup truck that had major front end damage as well as another vehicle that appeared to have been parked prior to being struck by the Mazda. The male stated he was not injured.

Officers were able to identify the driver of the vehicle as 26 year old Rohnert Park resident, Adam Reichmuth. Reichmuth said he was drinking at Friars Tucks in Cotati and was driving a girl to Raley's when he got into the collision. As the officers were speaking to Reichmuth they became suspicious of his intoxication. Reichmuth displayed obvious signs of alcohol intoxication. They conducted an investigation and determined Reichmuth was driving with a blood alcohol content (BAC) nearly three times the legal limit. Reichmuth was arrested for driving while intoxicated and subsequently transported and booked into the county jail. There were reports of a passenger in the vehicle, but she had left the scene prior to our arrival. Officers searched the area in an attempt to find the passenger, but were unable to locate the female passenger.

The DDVIP app helps find nearby bars and restaurants that feature free incentives for the designated sober driver, from free non-alcoholic drinks to free appetizers and more.
